

How to Load a Standard MIDI File - microSTATION

1. Insert an SD card into your microSTATION
2. Press GLB/Media button
3. Press Down cursor button until display reads as follows:
Global/Media
^Media >
4. Press the Right cursor button once and then press the Down cursor button until the display reads
<Media
^Format >
5. Press the right cursor button twice to format the card.

After the formatting system has been completed, eject your card and bring it over to your computer. You will need a card reader to access the SD card on your computer.

6. When it is mounted on your computer, it will show up as an external drive. If you are using a Windows-based computer, it will show up in "Computer". If you are on a Mac, it will show up on your desktop as a mounted disk image.
7. When you open up the card, you will find the directory structure reads as follows:

Korg

└MICRO_ST

8. Copy your MIDI files to the MICRO_ST folder.
9. After the file has been copied to the card, safely remove the card/card reader from your computer. For assistance in doing this on a Windows OS, please click here:

After the card has been removed from your computer, put the card in the SD card slot of your microSTATION.

10. To load your SMF, press the GLB/Media button. Press Down cursor button until display reads as follows:
Global/Media
^Media >
11. Press the Right cursor button once and the display reads
<Media
^Load >
12. Press the right cursor once, and then the down cursor button twice and the display will read:

<Media

^Load SMF >

13. Press the right cursor once, and it should display your most recently loaded SMF.
14. Press the right cursor button once more and you can choose the Sequence location to load it to.
15. When you have confirmed the sequence location, press the right cursor one more time. It will ask "OK?" Press the right cursor button one more time.
16. To play your MIDI file, you can now press the SEQ button and press the PLAY button.
